KEARSLEY HIGH SCHOOL FRONT LOOP

Kearsley High School is proud to announce our second “Quarantine Edition” Senior Salute. The salute will be at the front loop of the high school. Teachers and staff will be positioned along the loop, where individual yard signs with each senior’s photo will be displayed. Graduating seniors will drive their vehicles along the loop, ending in the student parking lot.

Guidelines for participation are as follows:

- 📖 Please plan to arrive at the high school between 6:00 and 6:30p.m. via the south entrance of the main bus loop.
- 📖 Please stay in your vehicle. Mr. Duplanty and Mr. Wiskur will direct you to drive thru the loop slowly while viewing your classmates’ portraits on their yard signs.
- 📖 You must be inside of your vehicle, not riding in the bed of pick-ups, open backs of SUVs, or on top of car hoods or trunks. You will proceed through the loop in your vehicle, waving at teachers and staff, and viewing all of your fellow classmates’ portraits placed along the loop. Students do not all need to arrive at the same time. It is really nice if we have a steady stream of cars between 6:00p.m. and 6:30p.m. Last year, cars were able to make two passes in about 45 minutes. This year, I only want cars to make the loop one time before parking in the student lot.
- 📖 Once your vehicle has made the loop, you will be directed to park in the student lot, where two stations will be set up. One station will distribute a wellness gift bag provided by Parents and Ms. Collins, our College Advisor, will be at a second station with some individual giveaways.
- 📖 Once you have visited the two stations in the student parking lot, you can walk to the front loop to collect your yard sign and leave the property. You must wait for the directive from Mr. Moore and Mr. Doyle before removing your sign. I really want all seniors, even the late arrivals, to be able to view all of the signs. The whole purpose of this is to allow the Class of 2021 to see their classmates’ portraits, many of whom you haven’t seen in a year and a half. It really wouldn’t be fair if we let students pull their signs at the beginning of the procession.
